Act No. 52, 1932.

An Act to reduce the rate imposed by section nine of the Sydney Harbour Bridge Act, 1922, as amended by subsequent Acts; to amend that Act as so amended; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 21st December, 1932.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Sydney Harbour Bridge (Rates) Act, 1932." Short title.

2. The Sydney Harbour Bridge Act, 1922, as amended by subsequent Acts, is amended by inserting next after subsection one of section nine the following new subsection:— Amendment of Act No. 28, 1932, s. 9. (Rate—imposition and amount.)

(1A) For the year one thousand nine hundred and thirty-three and for each succeeding year the rate of one-half of a penny in the pound imposed by subsection one of this section is hereby reduced to a rate of one-third of a penny in the pound.

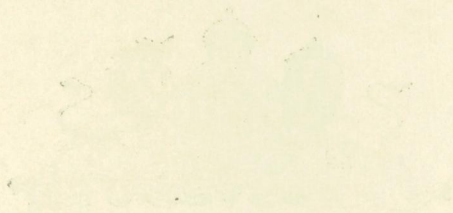
I have examined this Bill, and find it to correspond in all respects with the Bill as finally passed by both Houses.
