B^E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of 5 the same, as follows :--

(2) The West Scholarships Act, 1930, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the West Scholarships Act, 10 1930-1933.

Sec. 13. (By-laws.) 2. The West Scholarships Act, 1930, is amended—
(a) (i) by omitting from subsection four of section six the word "amounts" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "maximum annual amount";

- (ii) by omitting from the same subsection the word "periods" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "maximum period";
- (iii) by inserting next after the same subsection the following new subsection :-- 10

(5) The trustees may by resolution from time to time determine—

(a) the amount (not exceeding the maximum annual amount prescribed) payable by way of scholarship in any year 15 to each of the persons holding scholarships under this Act;

(b) the period (not exceeding the prescribed maximum period) during which a scholarship shall be tenable. 20

(b) (i) by omitting from paragraph (d) of subsection one of section thirteen the word "amounts" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "maximum annual amount";

 (ii) by inserting next after the same subsection 25 the following new subsection:—

(1A) The by-laws may empower the Minister, on the recommendation of the West Scholarships Trustees, to waive compliance with the provisions of any by-law in any 30 particular case.
