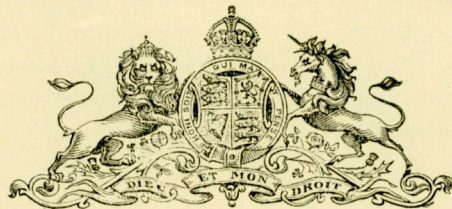

### Act No. 35, 1936.

An Act to make certain provisions in relation to loans raised by the Sydney County Council; to amend the Gas and Electricity Act, 1935, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 22nd July, 1936.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

**1.** (1) This Act may be cited as the "Gas and Electricity (Amendment) Act, 1936." Short title  
and citation.

(2) The Gas and Electricity Act, 1935, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Gas and Electricity Act, 1935-1936."
