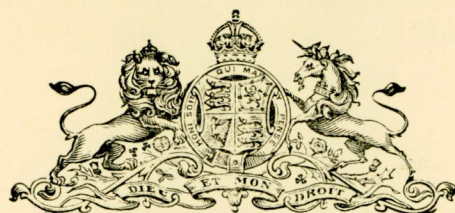

Local Government (Elections) Bill.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

UNDER the existing law the elections of aldermen and councillors of municipalities and shires and of aldermen of the City of Sydney, are directed to be held in December, 1940.

The object of this Bill is to postpone these elections until December, 1941.
