An Act to alter the name of the body corporate constituted by the Returned Sailors and Soldiers' Imperial League of Australia (New South Wales Branch) Incorporation Act, 1935; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 25th March, 1941.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Returned Sailors and Soldiers' Imperial League of Australia (New South Wales Branch) Incorporation Amendment Act, 1941." Short title, citation and commencement.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

At the 25th Annual Federal Congress of the Returned Sailors and Soldiers' Imperial League of Australia held in November, 1940, the Rules of the League were amended to change its name to "The Returned Sailors, Soldiers and Airmen's Imperial League of Australia."

The New South Wales Branch of the League was incorporated under the Returned Sailors and Soldiers' Imperial League of Australia (New South Wales Branch) Incorporation Act, 1935, and the purpose of this Bill is to amend that Act to give effect to the change in the name of the body corporate.
