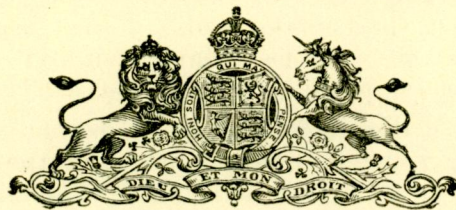

An Act to amend the Sydney Mechanics School of Arts Incorporation Act of 1886 in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 22nd November, 1940.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Sydney Mechanics School of Arts (Amendment) Bill, 1940.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THIS Bill is designed to amend the Act of 1886 incorporating the Sydney Mechanics' School of Arts. By that Act the Committee controlling the Institution is to consist of twelve committee-men. Experience has shown that it is difficult to secure the services of so large a Committee, and it is proposed that from a date to be proclaimed the Committee shall consist of not less than five nor more than ten members.

It is proposed to further amend the Act of Incorporation by amending section 15 to provide for the accounts of the Institution being audited by two auditors instead of three as at present. The Act is not altered in any other respect.
