BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- (2) There shall be credited to the Renewal Reserve Account as soon as practicable after the first day of January in each year an amount calculated at a rate which shall be determined by the Colonial Treasurer on the capital debt as at the thirty-first day of December immediately preceding. For the purposes of this subsection the capital debt shall be deemed exclusive of any sinking fund contributions, and shall also be deemed to have been reduced by the sum of forty thousand three hundred and ninety-two pounds fifteen shillings and ten pence.
- (3) The Renewal Reserve Account shall be credited half-yearly with interest on the daily credit balance at such rate as the Colonial Treasurer may from time to time direct.

(5) The Renewal Reserve Account shall be drawn upon only for purposes of investment or re-investment or for renewing or replacing capital assets:

Provided that the Minister may authorise the expenditure of any balance at credit of such Account in excess of twenty-five thousand pounds towards extending the works, but subject to such conditions of repayment as the Colonial Treasurer may direct. Interest on any such expenditure shall be credited to the Account at the rate of four per centum per annum.


(6) If the Minister considers the amount at credit of the Working Account insufficient to meet the contribution referred to in subsection two of this section having regard to the charges referred to in subsection two of section thirteen of this Act, such contribution or portion thereof may be allowed to remain a charge on the Working Account.



Interest accruing from such investments or such deposit shall be regularly added to the Account and invested in like manner.

(5) The Renewal Reserve Account shall be drawn upon only for purposes of investment or re-investment or for renewing or replacing capital assets:

Provided that the Minister may authorise the expenditure of any balance at credit of such Account in excess of twenty-five thousand pounds towards extending the works, but subject to such conditions of repayment as the Colonial Treasurer may direct. Interest on any such expenditure shall be credited to the Account at the rate of four per centum per annum.

(6) If the Minister considers the amount at credit of the Working Account insufficient to meet the contribution referred to in subsection two of this section having regard to the charges referred to in subsection two of section thirteen of this Act, such contribution or portion thereof may be allowed to remain a charge on the Working Account.

Interest on the amount of the deferred contribution at a rate to be approved by the Colonial Treasurer, shall be credited to the Renewal Reserve Account and debited to the Working Account for the period during which such contribution so remains a charge: Provided that if any such contribution be made on or before the thirty-first day of August in the year in which it becomes payable in accordance with subsection two of this section, no interest shall be credited or debited as aforesaid.
