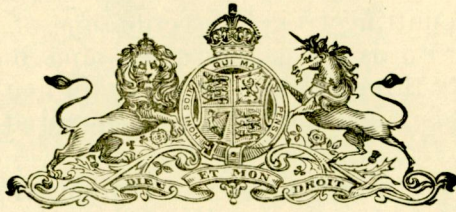

An Act to make further provision in relation to the preparation of rolls of citizens in the City of Sydney, and of rolls of electors in municipalities and shires; to make certain provisions in relation to the control and management by councils of abattoirs; for these purposes to amend the Local Government Act, 1919, the Local Government (Electoral Provisions) Act, 1941, and certain other Acts; and for purposes connected therewith. Local Government (Amendment).

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

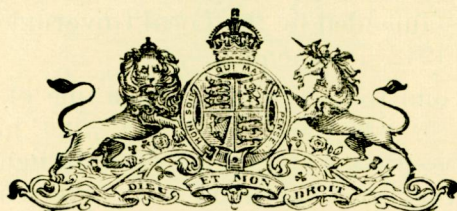

Page 3, clause 3. *After line 37 insert—*

“The power conferred by this subsection shall not extend to authorise the making of ordinances prohibiting or regulating the sale or exposure for sale within the area of any such council, of tinned goods.”

LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT, 1973

Section 104. (1) The provisions of this Act shall apply to every local authority established under this Act.

(2) The provisions of this Act shall apply to every local authority established under this Act.

The power conferred by this section shall not be exercised so as to confer the power of appointment or removal of any member of any such council of local authority.

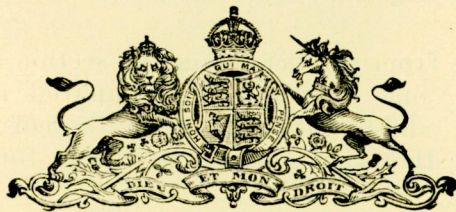
