1. This Act may be cited as the "Local Government" (Amendment) Act, 1943."

2. (1) The Local Government (Electoral Provisions) Act, 1941, as amended by the Local Government (Amendment) Act, 1942, is amended—

- (a) by omitting from subsection one of section five the words "one thousand nine hundred and forty-three" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "one thousand nine hundred and fortyfour";
- (b) by omitting from subsection one of section ten the words "one thousand nine hundred and forty-three" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "one thousand nine hundred and fortyfour";
- (c) by omitting from subsection one of section eleven the words "one thousand nine hundred and forty-three" wherever occurring and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "onethousand nine hundred and forty-four";
- (d) by omitting from subsection four of section eleven the words "one thousand nine hundred and forty-three" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "one thousand nine hundred and forty-four".

(2) It shall not be necessary for the council of an area to cause an original roll of electors or a supplementary roll of electors to be prepared in the year one thousand nine hundred and forty-three.




