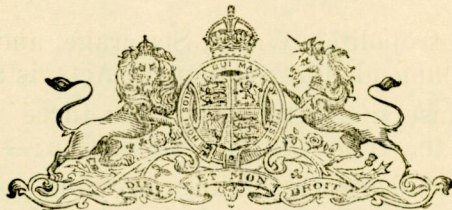

An Act to make further provision in relation to the remission of the capital indebtedness of the Metropolitan Water, Sewerage, and Drainage Board to the State; for this purpose to amend the Metropolitan Water, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1924-1941; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 5th May, 1943.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Metropolitan Water, Sewerage, and Drainage (Capital Indebtedness) Act, 1943."

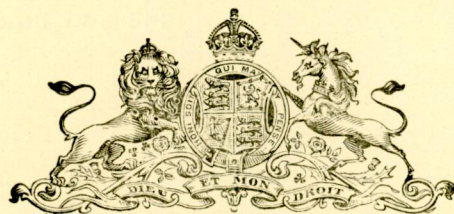

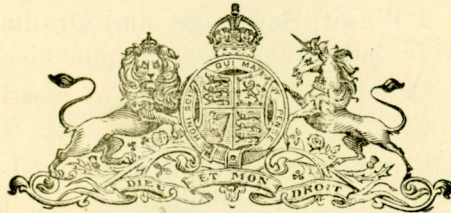
