Definition.

2. In this Act unless the context or subject matter otherwise indicates or requires—

"Fund" means the fund known as the Sydney University Engineering School Memorial Lecture Fund, which was collected for the purpose of providing for an annual memorial lecture to perpetuate the memory of graduates and undergraduates of the Peter Nicol Russel School of Engineering who died whilst on active service during the Great War, 1914-1919.

Authority to appoint the University of Sydney sole trustee.

**3.** (1) The trustees of the Fund are hereby authorised to appoint the University of Sydney sole trustee of the Fund.

(2) (a) Such appointment may be made under and in accordance with the Trustee Act, 1925, as amended by subsequent Acts.

(b) By such appointment the trustees shall be discharged from the trust.


