Act No. 26, 1945.

An Act to enable the Bulli Shire Council to sell to Australian Iron & Steel Limited portion of certain lands acquired for the purpose of public recreation; to amend the Local Government Act, 1919; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 22nd October, 1945.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Bulli (Slacky Flat) Land Sale Act, 1945." Short title.

**2.** Notwithstanding anything contained in any Act, the Bulli Shire Council may, upon such conditions as it deems fit, transfer to Australian Iron & Steel Limited (hereinafter referred to as "the company") the land described in the First Schedule to this Act in consideration of—

- (a) the payment by the company to the said council of the sum of three hundred and fifty pounds, and
- (b) the transfer by the company to the said council of the land described in the Second Schedule to this Act.

Upon the transfer of the land described in the Second Schedule to this Act to the Bulli Shire Council pursuant to paragraph (b) of this section the said council shall hold such land for public recreation purposes.

**3.** The proceeds of the sale shall be paid into the general fund of the Bulli Shire Council and shall be expended by that council in the improvement of—

- (a) the residue of the land comprised in Certificate of Title Volume 5148 Folio 85 remaining after transfer to the company of the land described in the First Schedule to this Act; or
- (b) the land described in the Second Schedule to this Act after transfer thereof to the council pursuant to section two of this Act.

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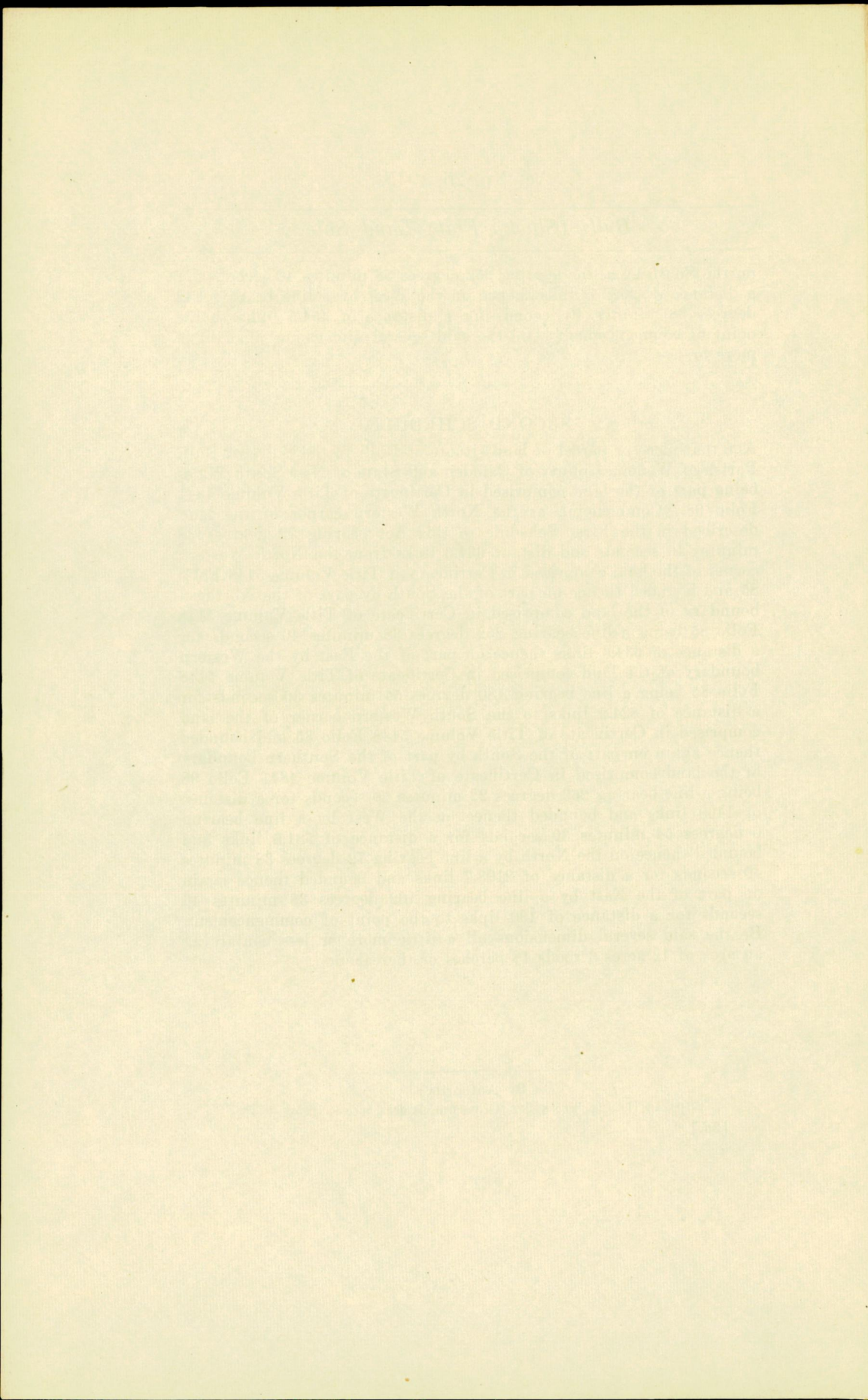

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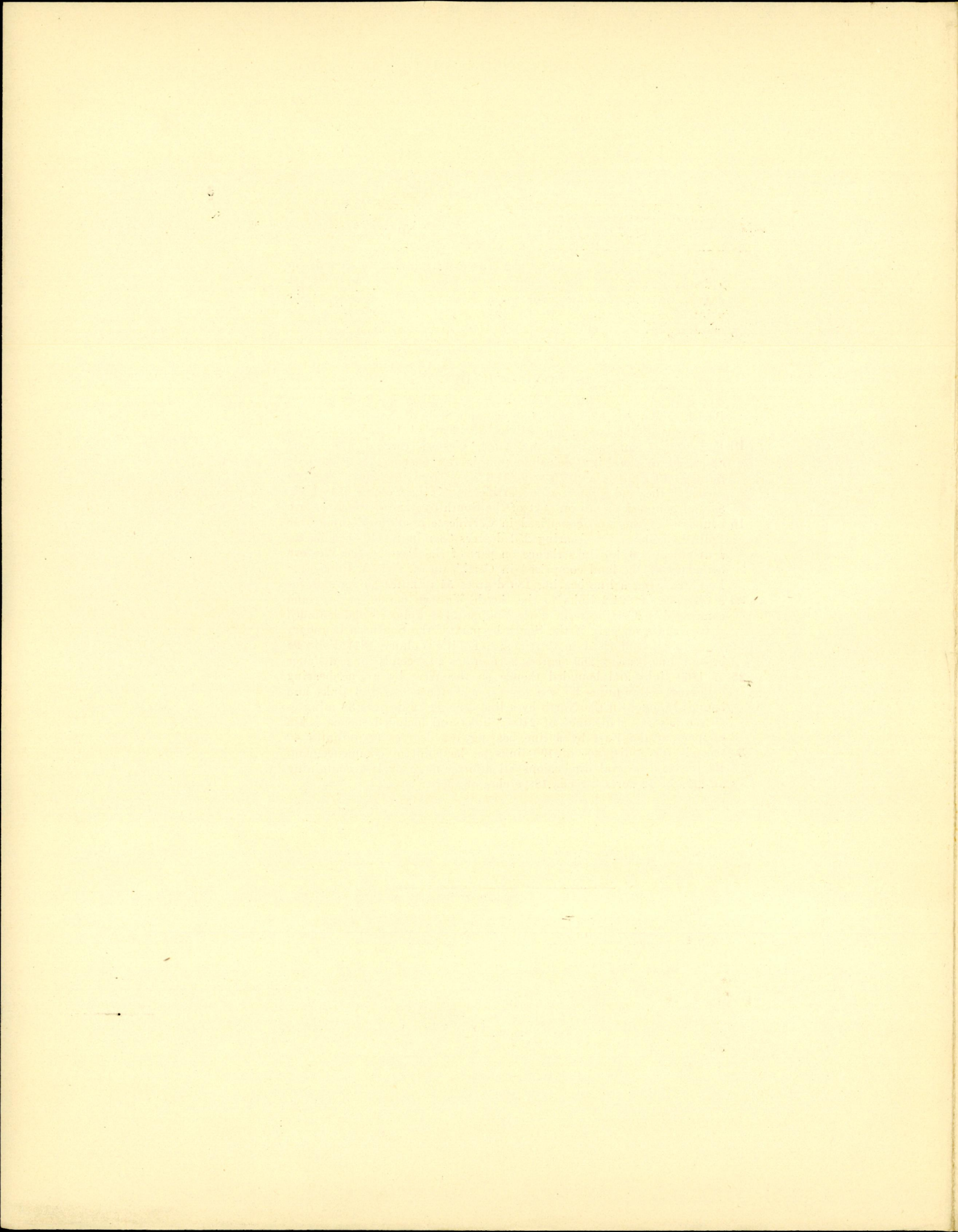

## Bulli (Slacky Flat) Land Sale Bill.

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### EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE object of this Bill is to empower the Bulli Shire Council to transfer to Australian Iron & Steel Limited 11 acres 1 rood 34½ perches of land which is part of land purchased by the Council for the purpose of public recreation. In exchange for this land the Company is to transfer to the Council other adjoining land of an area of 12 acres 3 roods 18 perches and pay to the Council an amount of three hundred and fifty pounds.

The land and money so received by the Council are to be used for public recreation purposes.
