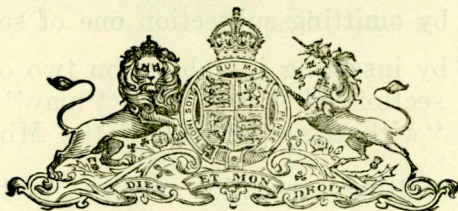

An Act to amend the Cattle Slaughtering and Diseased Animals and Meat Act, 1902, and certain other Acts in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 28th March, 1947.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Cattle Slaughtering and Diseased Animals and Meat (Amendment) Act, 1947." Short title and citation.

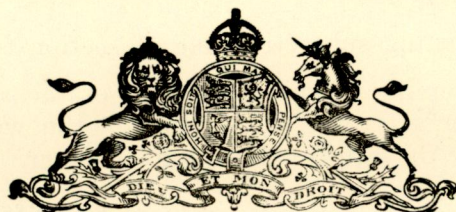
