

An Act to extinguish certain debts of the Councils of the Municipalities of Brewarrina and Cobar in respect of works of water supply; to reduce certain other debts of the Council of the Municipality of Cobar in respect of works of water supply; and for purposes connected therewith.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of 5 the same, as follows :--

1. This Act may be cited as the "Country Towns short title." Water Supply (Reduction of Debts) Act, 1945."

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

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THIS Bill provides for the extinguishment of the water supply capital debts to the Crown of the Brewarrina Municipal Council and the reduction of Cobar Municipal Council's water supply capital debts to £6,432 as at 31st December, 1941, by writing off the sum of £21,537 16s. Od. and accrued interest to 31st December, 1941. The cost of the recently completed renewal of the rising main at Cobar is also to be remitted.


