An Act to amend the Medical Practitioners Act, 1938-1939, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Medical Practitioners (Amendment) Act, 1945."
