An Act to amend the Metropolitan Water, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1924, and certain other Acts in certain respects; to validate certain matters; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 7th January, 1946.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Metropolitan Water, Sewerage, and Drainage (Amendment) Act, 1945." Short title and citation.

2. (1) The Metropolitan Water, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1924-1944, is amended by inserting next after subsection four of section nineteen the following new subsection:—

(5) The office of vice-president of the board shall not be deemed to be employment within the meaning of paragraph (a) of subsection two of section eight of the Public Service Act, 1902, as amended by subsequent Acts.

(2) Subsection one of this section shall be deemed to have commenced on the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-five.
