An Act to amend the Moratorium Act, 1932-1942, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 7th January, 1946.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—
