An Act to make further provision in relation to certain land vested in the Royal Agricultural Society of New South Wales as trustees under the Public Trusts Act, 1897; for this purpose to amend the Royal Agricultural Society Act, 1911, and certain other Acts; and for purposes connected therewith.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of

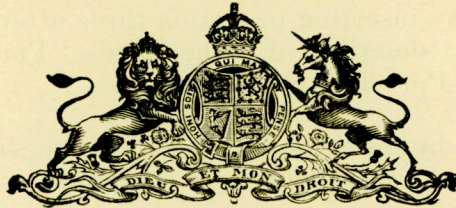
