Act No. , 1949.

An Act to sanction and provide for the construction of a Mental Hospital of the Farm Colony Type; to amend the Local Government Act, 1919, as amended by subsequent Acts, and for purposes connected therewith.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Farm Colony Type Mental Hospital Construction Act, 1949." Short title.

Farm Colony Type Mental Hospital Construction.

2. (1) (a) The carrying out of the work described in the Schedule to this Act is hereby sanctioned. **Work sanctioned.**

(b) The said work shall be deemed to be an authorised work within the meaning of the Public Works Act, 1912, as amended by subsequent Acts.

(c) The Minister for Public Works is empowered to carry out the said work and shall be the constructing authority for the same within the meaning of the said Act, as so amended, and shall enter into such contracts and take all such necessary steps for the proper execution thereof as such authority may think proper.

(d) The provisions of the Public Works Act, 1912, as amended by subsequent Acts, sections thirty-four, thirty-five, thirty-six and thirty-seven excepted, shall apply to and in respect of the said work.

(2) Without prejudice to the generality of subsection one of this section the provisions of section thirty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1912, as amended by subsequent Acts, shall apply to and in respect of any contracts referred to in paragraph (c) of subsection one of this section.

3. The cost of carrying out the said work (exclusive of land resumptions) is estimated at two million pounds, and such estimated cost shall not, under any circumstances, be exceeded by more than ten per centum.

4. The provisions of this Act shall have effect and any land acquired for the purposes of the said work may be used for or in connection with the construction and conduct of a mental hospital of the farm colony type notwithstanding anything contained in Part XIIA of the Local Government Act, 1919, as amended by subsequent Acts. **Part XIIA of Local Government Act, 1919, not to apply.**

- 15 (10) Other ancillary buildings as deemed necessary or desirable by the Constructing Authority.

SCHEDULE

The construction and equipment of a Mental Hospital of the farm type is estimated to cost as follows:

(1) Administration Building: Ward Block, designed to house 200 patients, in all with accommodations for 400 patients, including the hospital patients' block.

(2) Administrative buildings:

(a) Hospital block, including operating theater,
