Fire Brigades (Amendment) Bill, 1949.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to raise the Fire Brigades Board's borrowing limit to £500,000;
- (b) to empower the Governor to proclaim the maximum rate which may be levied by councils on the unimproved capital value of ratable land in a fire district;
- (c) to alter the amounts to be contributed to the fund of the board by councils, insurance companies and the Government to $12\frac{1}{2}$ per cent., 75 per cent. and $12\frac{1}{2}$ per cent., respectively.

The amendments under paragraphs (b) and (c) are to take effect from 1st January, 1950.

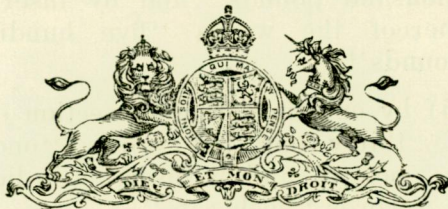

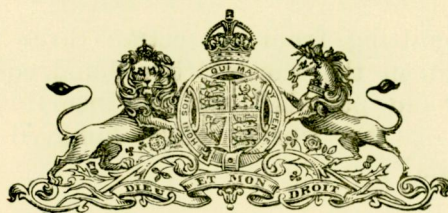
