Act No. 40, 1947.

An Act to repeal the Married Women (Lecturers and Teachers) Act, 1932, and the Married Women (Lecturers and Teachers) Amendment Act, 1935; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 19th December, 1947.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the "Married Women (Lecturers and Teachers) Acts Repeal Act, 1947." Short title.

**2.** The Married Women (Lecturers and Teachers) Act, 1932, and the Married Women (Lecturers and Teachers) Amendment Act, 1935, are hereby repealed. Repeal of Act No. 28, 1932, and Act No. 49 1935.
