EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to omit from subsection five of section thirty certain words which provide a particular defence to a person on whose behalf or at whose place of business goods are sold at a greater price than the maximum price fixed in relation thereto and who is charged with an offence against the section in respect of such sale;
- (b) to repeal the section which provides that the Act shall remain in force for a limited period.
