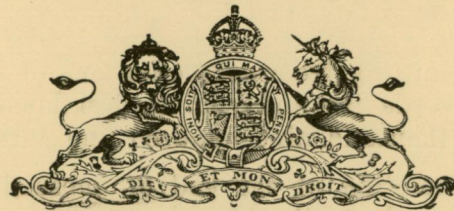

1. The Board of Directors (Board)

(c) by meeting at the end of each year, the Board shall determine the amount of the annual dividend to be paid to the shareholders.

(d) if there is a person who has been elected to the Board and who is not a shareholder of the Corporation, the Board may, in its discretion, elect to pay to such person a salary or other compensation for the services rendered to the Corporation.
