An Act to amend the Roman Catholic Church Trust Property Act, 1936, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 24th March, 1950.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Roman Catholic Short title, Church Trust Property (Amendment) Act, 1950."

(2) The Roman Catholic Church Trust Property and commencement. Act, 1936, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Roman Catholic Church Trust Property Act, 1936-1950.

Short title, citation and commencement.

(3) This Act shall commence fourteen days after the day upon which the assent of His Majesty to this Act is signified.
