BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Roman Catholic Church Trust Property (Amendment) Act, 1950."

- (b) a reference in any Act or other instrument to the Diocese of Goulburn or to the trustees of the Roman Catholic Church for the Diocese of Goulburn shall be read and construed as a reference to the Archdiocese of Canberra and Goulburn or to the trustees of the Roman Catholic Church for the Archdiocese of Canberra and Goulburn, as the case may be.

(2) Nothing contained in the Roman Catholic Church Trust Property (Amendment) Act, 1950, shall prejudice or affect in any way the continuity of the body corporate referred to in subsection one of this section, but the same shall continue notwithstanding the provisions of the said Act.

(3) The alteration of name effected by subsection one of this section shall not affect any property, powers, rights, authorities, duties, functions, liabilities or obligations of the body corporate referred to in subsection one of this section, or render defective any legal or other proceedings instituted or to be instituted by or against the said body corporate.

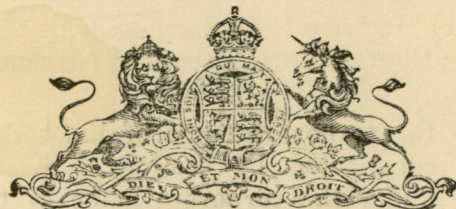
