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#### State Transport (Co-ordination) Amendment Bill, 1947.

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE.**

THE provisions of section 18 of the State Transport (Co-ordination) Act, 1931-1945, under which licensees of public motor vehicles (which term includes "aircraft"—section 3 (1)) may be required to make payments based upon or limited by reference to the mileage travelled by such vehicles or by passengers therein, are inapt in their application to aircraft as the mileage travelled is referable to mileage travelled "along a public street." The object of this Bill is to make section 18 applicable to aircraft by removing from the section the references to a public street.

The Bill also amends the Transport (Division of Functions) Act, 1932-1943, to make it clear that the provisions of the transport legislation relating to aircraft are administered by the Commissioner for Road Transport and Tranways.

The Bill also amends the Air Navigation Act, 1938, to restrict the operation of the Commonwealth Air Navigation Regulations, as in force in New South Wales under that Act, in their application to aircraft required to be licensed under the State Transport (Co-ordination) Act, 1931.
