Act No. 25, 1949.

An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the Government Railways Fund, the Road Transport and Traffic Fund, the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund, the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund, and the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund, towards the services of the Year 1949-1950.

[Assented to, 26th September, 1949.]

W HEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and Preamble. loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled,

have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of Thirteen millions five hundred and forty-four thousand one hundred pounds, that is to say—

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the sum of Six millions ten thousand and nine hundred pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty.

Out of the Government Railways Fund, the sum of Five million seven hundred and sixteen thousand one hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Railways during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty.

Out of the Road Transport and Traffic Fund, the sum of One hundred and thirty thousand pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Road Transport and Tramways during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty.

Out of the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund, the sum of One million three hundred and twenty thousand seven hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Road Transport and Tramways during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty.

Out of the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund, the sum of One hundred and forty-three thousand two hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Road Transport and Tramways during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty.

Out of the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund, the sum of Two hundred and twenty-three thousand two hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Maritime Services Board of New South Wales during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty.

And whereas we desire to make good out of the said Funds the sum so granted to His Majesty: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-
