**COAL MINING INDUSTRY LONG SERVICE LEAVE

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE object of this bill is to extend the provisions of the Coal Mining Industry Long Service Leave Act, 1950, to employees in the coal mining industry in respect of whom awards conferring long service leave benefits have been made since the commencement of that Act.
