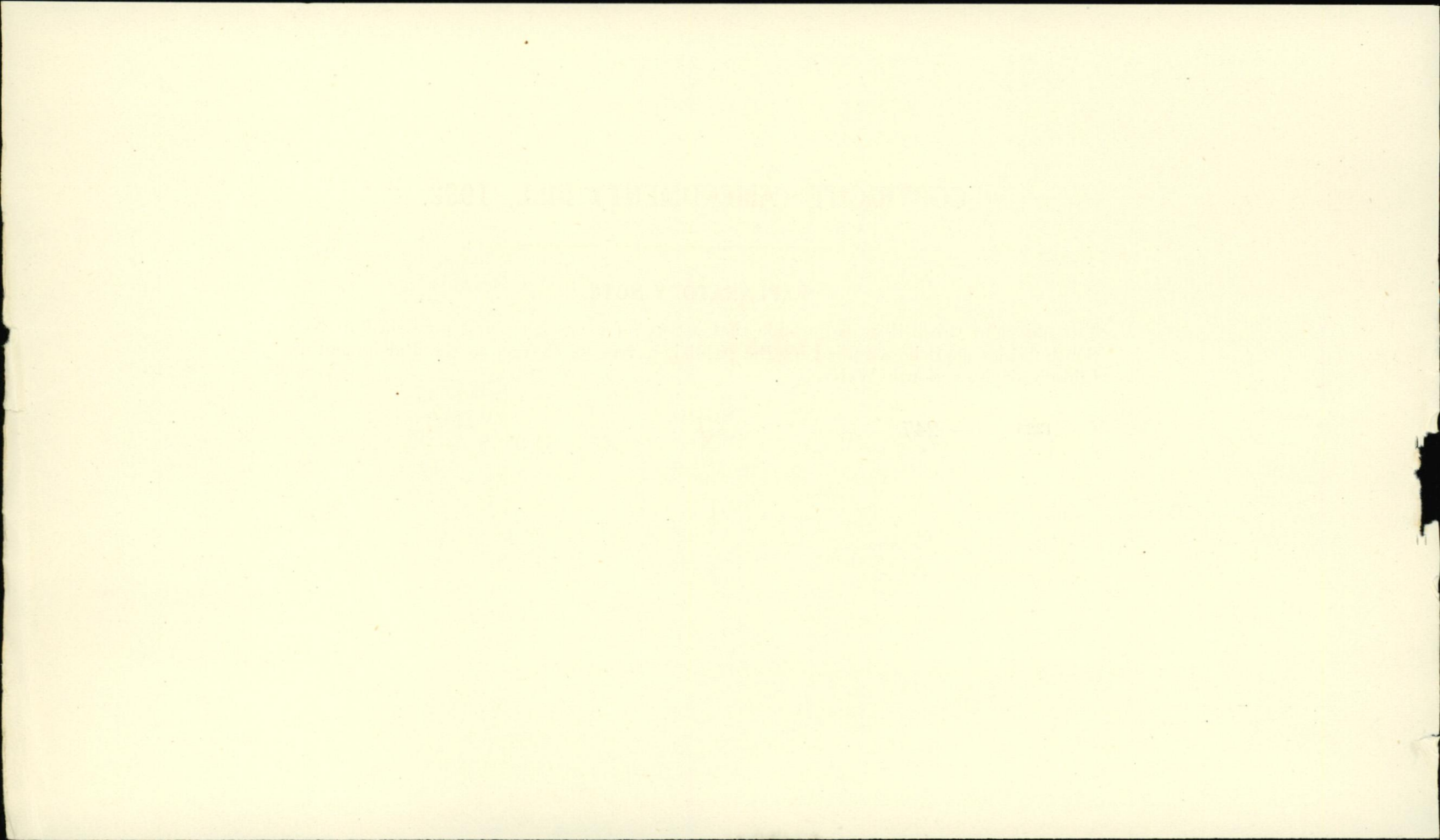

THE object of this Bill is to provide that a copy of every book first published in New South Wales shall be supplied by the publisher, free of charge, to the Parliamentary Library of New South Wales.

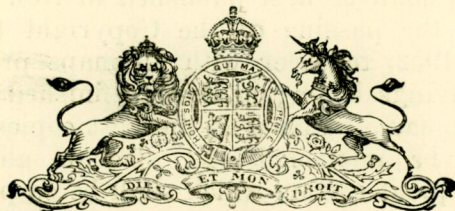
