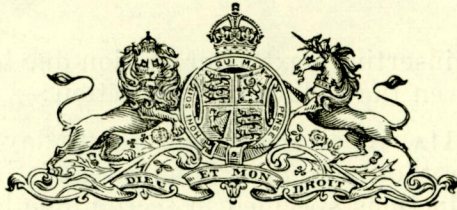

An Act to increase superannuation allowances payable from and deductions from salaries to be credited to the Government Railways Superannuation Account; for these purposes to amend the Government Railways Act, 1912-1951; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 17th December, 1951.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

Section 101

101.1. The purpose of this section is to provide for the orderly and efficient management of the affairs of the organization.

101.5. The Board of Directors shall have the authority to determine the compensation of the officers and directors of the organization.

101.6. The Board of Directors shall have the authority to determine the qualifications of the officers and directors of the organization.

101.7. The Board of Directors shall have the authority to determine the powers and duties of the officers and directors of the organization.
