An Act to amend the Legislative Assembly Members Superannuation Act, 1946-1949, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 17th December, 1951.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Legislative Assembly Members Superannuation (Amendment) Act, 1951." Short title, citation and commencement.

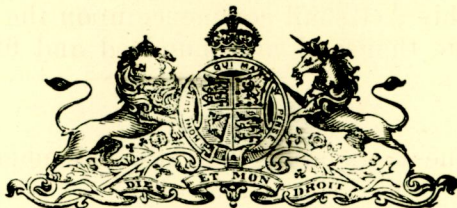

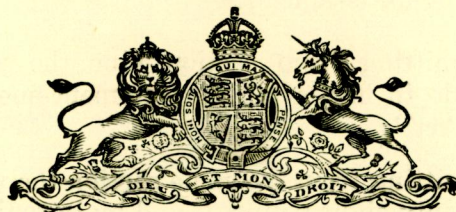

LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY MEMBERS SUPERANNUATION (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1951.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE purposes of this Bill are to amend the Legislative Assembly Members Superannuation Act, 1946-1949,—

- (a) to increase by fifty per centum the amount of contributions payable to the Legislative Assembly Members Provident Fund;
- (b) to increase by fifty per centum the amount payable by way of pensions out of the Fund to persons entitled thereto.

The provisions of this Bill will operate from first day of January, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-two.
