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

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

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE objects of this Bill are-

- to provide for the payment to the Country Main Roads Fund of the proceeds derived from the increase in motor vehicles taxation imposed by the Motor Vehicles (Taxation) Act, 1950;
- (2) to impose upon the Country Main Roads Fund the liability for debt charges on loan moneys expended on developmental roads and developmental works including liability for accrued arrears of such debt charges as may be determined from time to time by the Colonial Treasurer;
- (3) to relieve the Developmental Roads Fund as from 1st July, 1942, of the payments required by subsections (5) and (6) of section 29 of the Main Roads Act to be made to the County of Cumberland Main Roads Fund and the Country Main Roads Fund.
