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on the construction, reconstruction, maintenance and repair thereof or on the purchase of road-making plant for use in connection therewith, or in making payments to local authorities for the construction, reconstruction, maintenance and repair of such roads or for the purchase of road-making plant for use in connection with such roads.

(f) by inserting at the end of section forty-two the Sec. 42.

following new subsection:—

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Sec. 42. (Engineering and clerical charges.)

- (3) In the case of any work, in respect of which a notification that the work has been done to the satisfaction of the Commissioner is given after the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-one, and in respect of which the working plans and specifications in accordance with the standards approved by the Commissioner have been prepared by a council, the amount allowed as commission under this section shall be an amount equivalent to two pounds ten shillings per centum of the cost of the works.
- (2) (a) The amendments made by subparagraph
  (i) of paragraph (a) and subparagraph (i) of paragraph
  25 (c) of subsection one of this section shall be deemed to commence upon the date of commencement of the Motor Vehicles (Taxation) Act, 1951.
- (b) The amendments made by subparagraphs

  paragraphs (d) and (e) of subsection one of this section
  shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of
