An Act to increase the superannuation allowances payable to retired members of the Police Force; for this purpose to amend the Police Regulation (Superannuation) Act, 1906-1944; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 17th December, 1951.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

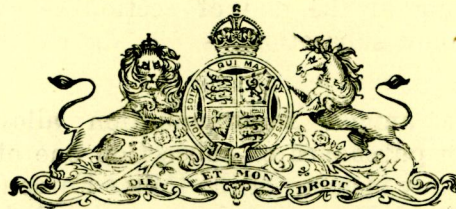

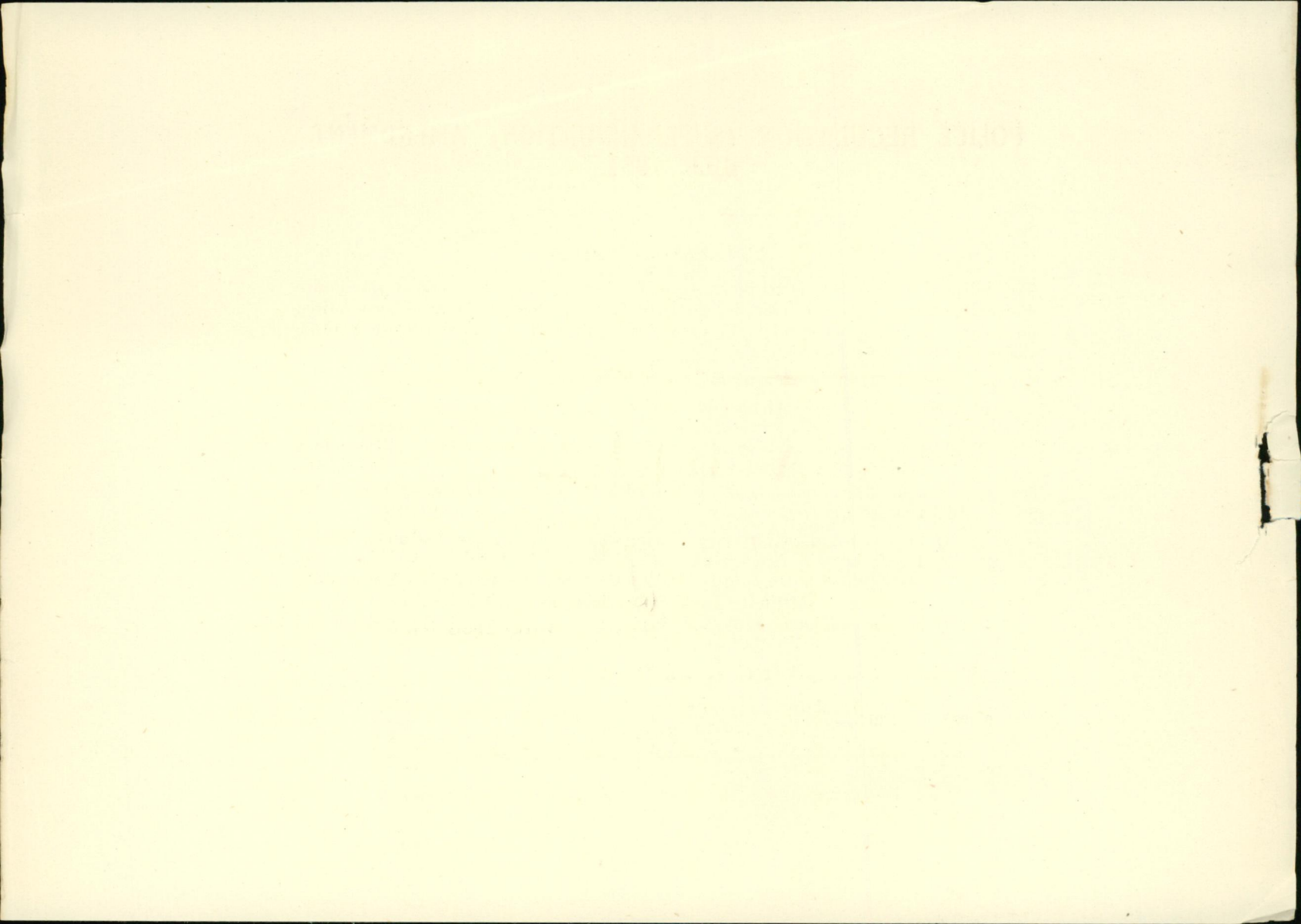
POLICE REGULATION (SUPERANNUATION) AMENDMENT BILL, 1951.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE purpose of this Bill is to increase pensions payable to members of the Police Force who, at 1st January, 1952, have retired from the Service or have been retired on account of injury received in the execution of their duty. The increase is to be the lesser of the following amounts:—

- (a) one-fifth of the pension payable to such member; or
- (b) (i) in the case of such member having retired under section 7 of the Police Regulation (Superannuation) Act, 1906, the difference between the pension payable to such member and that which would be payable to a member of the Police Force retiring on the 1st January, 1952, and having equivalent rank and service as such firstmentioned member had at the time of his retirement, or
- (ii) in the case of such member having been granted a pension under section 10 of the said Act the difference between the pension payable to such member and an amount equivalent to three-quarters of the salary payable to a member of the Police Force retiring on the 1st January, 1952, and having equivalent rank and service as such firstmentioned member had at the time of his disablement.

The increases are to take effect from the 1st January, 1952.
