PREVENTION OF CRUELTY TO ANIMALS (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1951.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

The Justices Act, 1902, provides that an information or complaint may, unless some other time is specially limited by the Act dealing with the matter, be laid or made at any time within six months from the time when the matter of the information or complaint arose.

Section 9 of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1901, which this Bill proposes to repeal, provides that every complaint under the Act shall be made within one month after the cause of complaint arose.
