BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

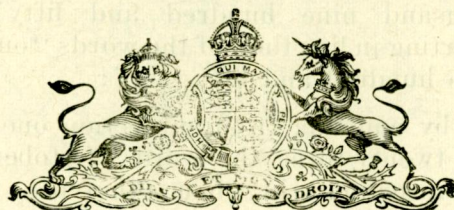

PUBLIC ACCOUNTANTS REGISTRATION (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1951.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to extend from 28th May, 1950, till 28th May, 1952, the date by which applicants for registration as registered public accountants, who are desirous of being credited with having passed some of the examinations of an approved institute of accountants before 28th May, 1948, must complete their examinations with the Public Accountants Registration Board;
- (b) to provide that the date by which annual roll fees payable by registered public accountants are to be paid shall be 1st January in each year in lieu of 1st October in each year.

ROBIC ACCOUNTANTS REGISTRATION (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1971

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Bill provides for the registration of accountants and the regulation of their conduct. It also provides for the establishment of a Council of Accountants and for the appointment of a Registrar of Accountants.
