B E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Civil Service Short title, (Amendment) Act, 1953''.

- (2) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced upon the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-three.
- (3) This Act shall be read and construed with the Civil Service Acts.

Where any superannuation allowance is at the date on which the assent of Her Majesty to this Act is signified payable to any person under the Civil Service Acts such superannuation allowance shall as from the commencement of this Act be increased by one-fifth, or by an amount equivalent to twenty-six pounds per annum, whichever is the greater, and any reference in the Civil Service Acts to any such superannuation allowance shall be read and construed as a reference to such superannuation allowance as so increased.
