W HEREAS the Australian Loan Council at its Preamble. seventy-second meeting held on the twenty-ninth and thirtieth days of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-four, decided in pursuance of Clause 3 (9) of Part I of the Agreement set out in the schedule to the Financial Agreement Act, 1944, that the amount to be borrowed for the loan programmes of the Commonwealth and the States for the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and
