Act No. , 1955.

An Act to provide for the appropriation of a certain sum out of the General Loan Account and for the application of that sum for certain Public Works and Services; and for purposes connected therewith.

WHEREAS the Australian Loan Council, at its Preamble. seventy-third meeting held on the twenty-first and twenty-second days of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-five, decided in pursuance of Clause 3 (9) of Part I of the Agreement set out in the schedule to the Financial Agreement Act, 1944, that the amount to be borrowed for the loan programmes of the Commonwealth and the States for the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six, shall be one hundred and ninety-three million

five hundred thousand pounds, and by unanimous decision allocated an amount of forty-nine million nine hundred and fifty thousand pounds to the State of New South Wales, BE it enacted therefore by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "General Loan Account Appropriation Act, 1955."

2. The sum of fifty-five million seven hundred and eighty thousand pounds is hereby appropriated from the General Loan Account for the public works and services hereunder set out, and shall, as required be applied as follows:—

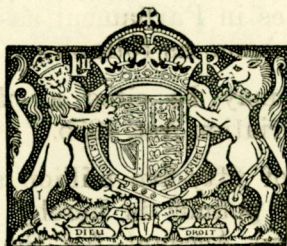

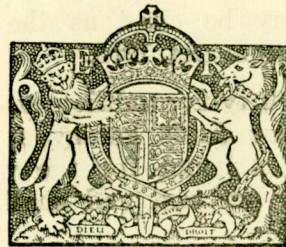

An Act to provide for the appropriation of a certain sum out of the General Loan Account and for the application of that sum for certain Public Works and Services; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 4th November, 1955.]

WHEREAS the Australian Loan Council at its Preamble. seventy-third meeting held on the twenty-first and twenty-second days of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-five, decided in pursuance of Clause 3 (9) of Part I of the Agreement set out in the schedule to the Financial Agreement Act, 1944, that the amount to be borrowed for the loan programmes of the Commonwealth and the States for the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six, shall be one hundred and ninety-three million
