Act No. 16, 1954.

An Act to make provision whereby the present Director of the New South Wales Government Engineering and Shipbuilding Undertaking may be continued in office for a certain period as such Director and also as a Commissioner of the Electricity Commission of New South Wales; for this purpose to amend the New South Wales Government Engineering and Shipbuilding Undertaking Act, 1943, and the Electricity Commission Act, 1950-1954; and for purposes connected therewith. BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

*New South Wales Government Engineering and Shipbuilding
Undertaking and Electricity Commission.*

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "New South Wales Government Engineering and Shipbuilding Undertaking and Electricity Commission Act, 1954."

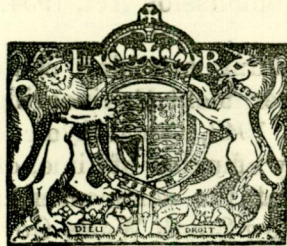

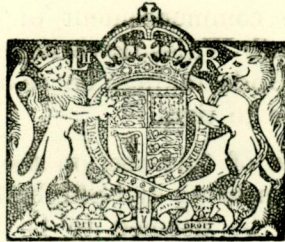
