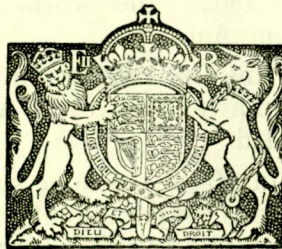

PUBLIC SERVICE (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1953.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE object of this Bill is—

- (a) to provide that any officer voluntarily retiring from the Public Service after attaining the age of sixty shall be paid pension from the date any extended leave acquired by such officer, if taken, would have commenced; and
- (b) to make other provisions incidental thereto.
