(2) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the twenty-sixth day of July, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-two.

2. The Commissioner for Railways shall cease to operate the railway constructed pursuant to the Richmond to Kurrajong Railway Act, 1919, and any duties or obligations imposed upon The Commissioner for Railways by the Government Railways Act, 1912, as amended by subsequent Acts, the Public Works Act, 1912, as amended by subsequent Acts, or any other Act of Parliament, or by agreement, contract, deed or by operation of law in relation to the said railway or any of the lands or works connected therewith or adjoining thereto, or the carriage of persons, animals and goods upon the said railway, are hereby extinguished.

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




