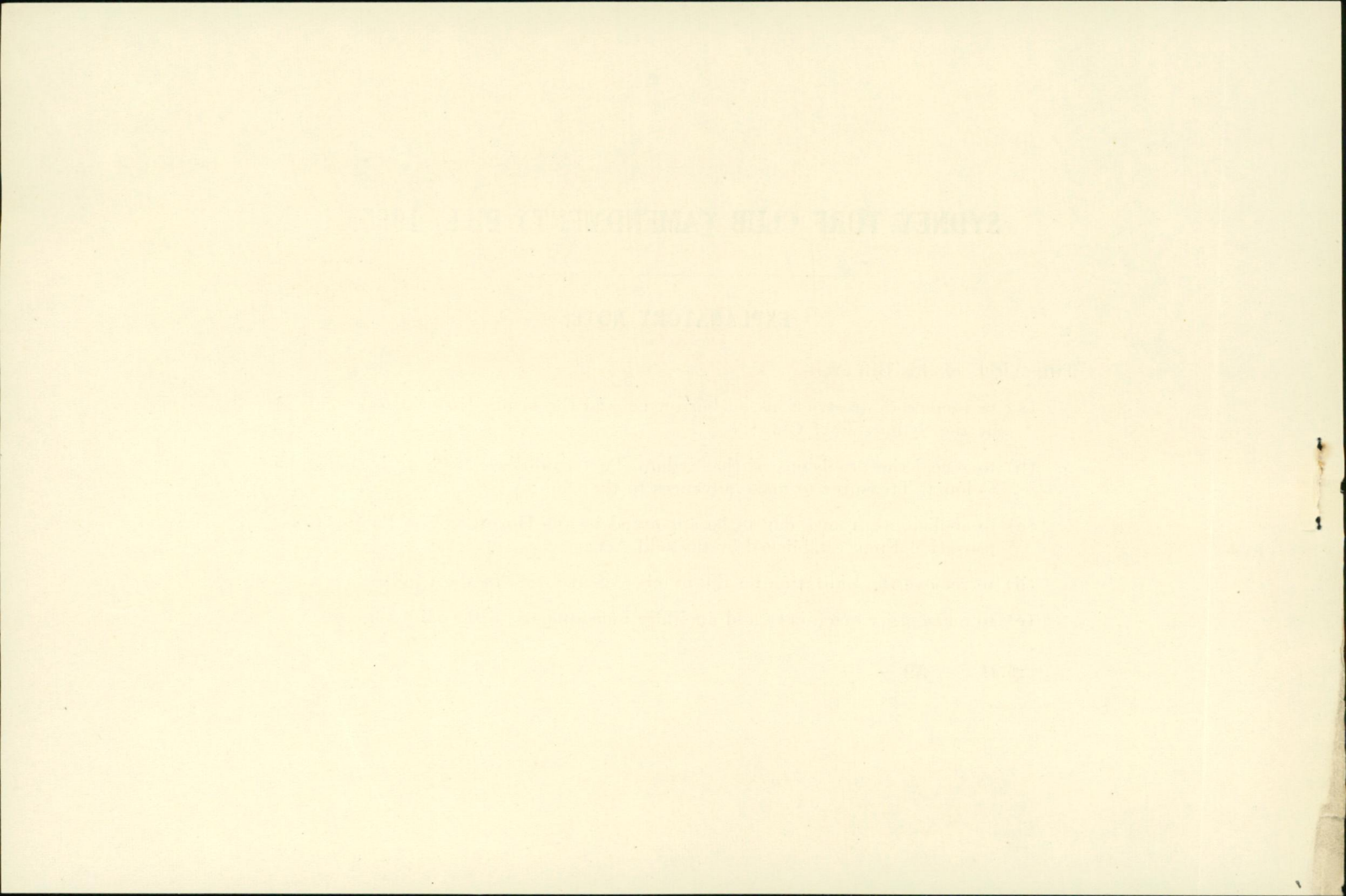

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to remove the restrictions on borrowing and the acquisition and sale of land by the Sydney Turf Club;
- (b) to repeal the provisions of the Sydney Turf Club Act, 1943, authorising the Colonial Treasurer to make advances to the Club;
- (c) to abolish, as from a day to be appointed by the Governor, the Racing Compensation Fund established by the said Act;
- (d) to remove the limitation on the number of members of the Club;
- (e) to make other machinery and ancillary amendments to the said Act.

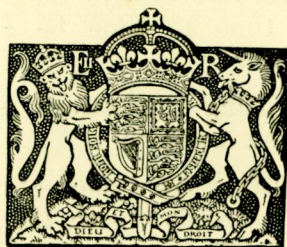
