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## **TAREE-WINGHAM WATER SUPPLY ADMINISTRATION (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1954.**

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### **EXPLANATORY NOTE.**

THE purpose of this Bill is to ratify an agreement for the variation of the agreement made between the Minister for Public Works and the Councils of the Municipalities of Taree and Wingham on 10th October, 1928, respecting the administration of certain works of water supply for those Municipalities.

The amending agreement provides that additional works of water supply may be constructed, and amends the basis of contributions to be made by the Municipalities of Taree and Wingham towards the costs and expenses of the Board of Management.
