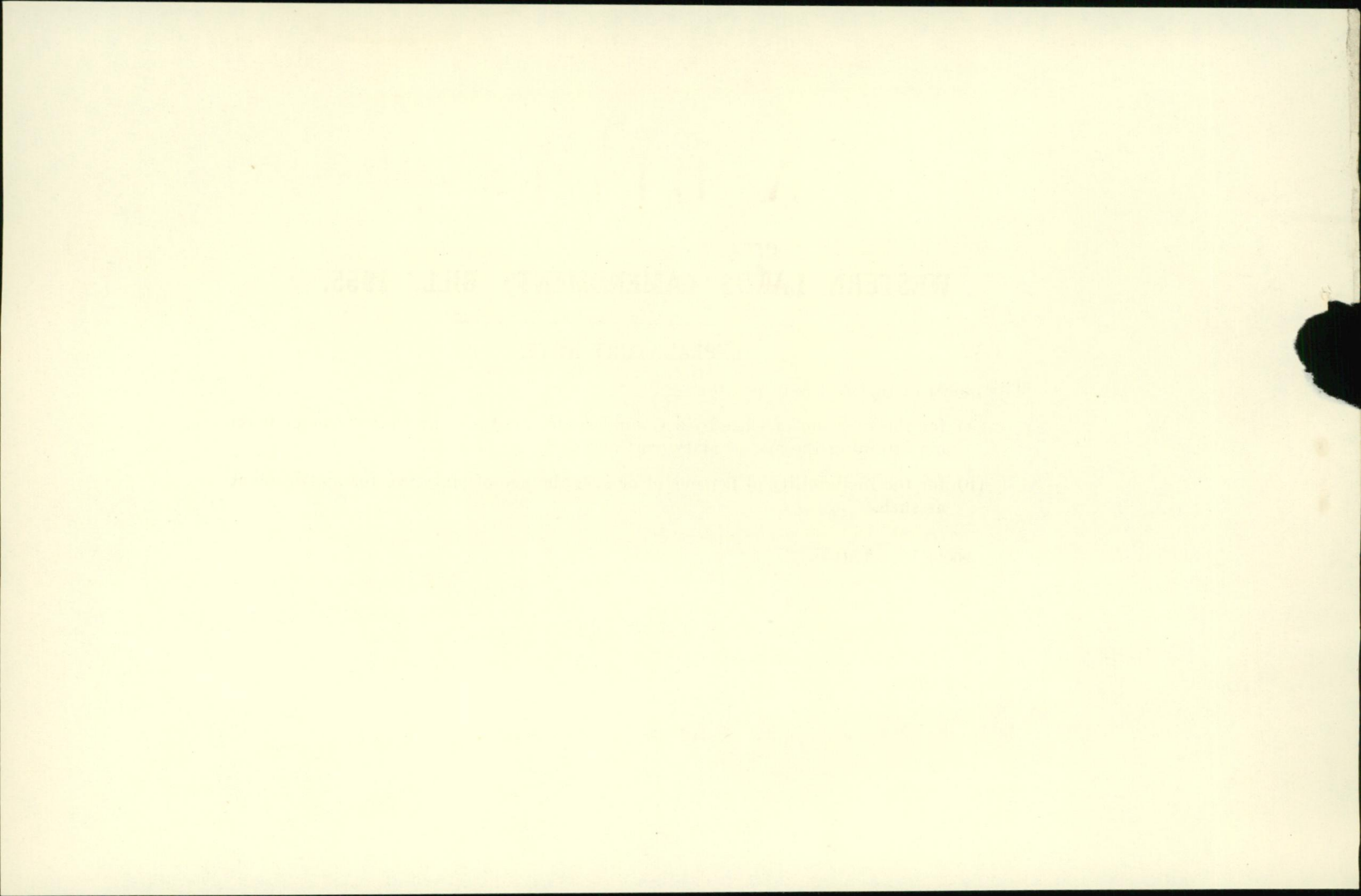

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE object of this Bill is to provide—

- (a) for the vacation of office by a Commissioner or Assistant Commissioner upon his attaining the age of sixty-five; and
- (b) for the ineligibility of persons of or over the age of sixty-five for appointment as such.

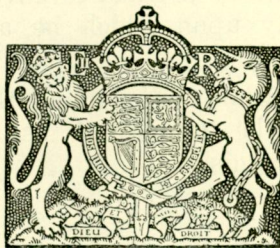
