

### DRIED FRUITS (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1957.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE.

The objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to require that moneys received by the New South Wales Dried Fruits Board under the Dried Fruits Act, 1939, as amended by subsequent Acts, be paid into a bank to the credit of the Dried Fruits Account instead of into an account in Special Deposits Account;
- (b) to empower the Board to invest in trustee investments moneys not immediately required for expenditure in the administration of the Act;


