## ELECTRICITY DEVELOPMENT (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1957.

### EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to require annual contributions to the Electricity Development Account constituted under the Electricity Development Act, 1945-1948, to be made only by The Electricity Commission of New South Wales, instead of by that Commission and certain other electricity supply authorities;
- (b) to provide that each such annual contribution shall be an amount equal to one-half of the subsidies paid or to be paid by The Electricity Authority of New South Wales during the year in respect of which that contribution is payable;
- (c) to make other provision consequent upon and ancillary to the foregoing.
