**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** (1) This Act may be cited as the "Fish River Water Supply Administration (Amendment) Act, 1957".

(2) The Fish River Water Supply Administration Act, 1945, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Fish River Water Supply Administration Act, 1945-1957.

**2.** The Fish River Water Supply Administration Act, 1945, is amended—

(a) (i) by omitting from subsection one of section three the words "Minister for Public Works" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "permanent head of the Department of Public Works";

(ii) by omitting subsection two of the same section and by inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection:—

(2) In the case of the illness, suspension or absence of the Administrator, the person for the time being acting in the office of the permanent head of the Department of Public Works shall have and may exercise and perform the powers, authorities, duties and functions of the Administrator.

(iii) by omitting from subsection three of the same section the words "of the Department concerned" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "and of the Public Service Board";

(iv) by omitting from the same subsection the words "to the Under Secretary of the Department of Public Works or to the person for the time being acting in his place or to any other" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "to any";

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- (b) by inserting next after section eight the <sup>New sec. 8A.</sup> following new section:—

8A. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of <sup>Fixing price-</sup> section eight of this Act or any contract made <sup>of water.</sup> thereunder the price to be paid for water supplied by the Administrator to any council, shall be at the rate of one shilling per thousand gallons. This subsection shall be deemed to have commenced upon the first day of January, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six.

(2) The Governor may from time to time, by regulation vary the price per thousand gallons to be paid by any council for water supplied by the Administrator in the year commencing on the first day of January, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine, and in each succeeding year commencing on the first day of January thereafter, and fix the minimum amount to be paid by any council in any one year irrespective of the quantity of water supplied.

- (c) by inserting next after section fifteen the <sup>New</sup> following new section:— <sup>sec. 15A.</sup>

15A. (1) The Administrator shall, during the <sup>Adjustment</sup> periods specified in the second column of the <sup>of contri-</sup> Third Schedule to this Act and applicable to the <sup>butions by</sup> relevant council deduct from the annual accounts <sup>councils to</sup> for water supplied by the Administrator to the <sup>cost of</sup> Lithgow City Council and the Blaxland Shire <sup>works.</sup> Council the respective amounts set out in the third column of the Third Schedule to this Act opposite the periods so specified.

(2) The Oberon Shire Council shall for the period of forty-five years commencing on the first day of January, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six, pay to the Administrator in respect of each year, in addition to its annual account for water supplied by the Administrator, the

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sum of three hundred and seven pounds, which sum shall be revenue received by the Administrator in pursuance of this Act.

(3) This section shall be deemed to have commenced upon the first day of January, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six.
