
THE objects of this Bill are to sanction and provide for the construction of-

- (b) an earthen block dam in the Murrumbidgee River adjacent to the weir referred to in paragraph (a);
- (c) a northern diversion canal approximately fifteen miles long and a southern diversion canal approximately ten miles long, both offtaking from near the weir referred to in paragraph (a);
- (d) flood protection levees consisting of earthen banks placed across natural depressions south of the Murrumbidgee River.

The Bill provides that the work shall be deemed an authorised work within the meaning of the Public Works Act, 1912, and that the Water Conservation and Irrigation Commission shall be the Constructing Authority for the work.

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
