**NEW SOUTH WALES GOVERNMENT ENGINEERING AND

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE objects of this Bill are to extend the power to invest moneys standing to the credit of the Depreciation Reserve Account established by the New South Wales Government Engineering and Shipbuilding Undertaking Act, 1943, so as to include power to invest such moneys in securities issued or guaranteed by the New South Wales Government, and to validate an investment of moneys from that Account already made in such a security.
